Sunday Groups & Activities

Junior Church runs during school term-time and takes place in the Church Hall (or outside if the weather is good). We start in church at the 10.30 service, then go out for lively stories, video, music, games or crafts in groups for different ages, from pre-school to much older. We come back into the church for communion and share what we have been up to with the church family!

Children's corner is a space at the back of the church where young children accompanied by their parents/carers will find toys and books to make use of during the service. There are also activity bags available for children to use either at the back or in the pews.

All-Age Services are held on the 2nd Sunday of the month. We serve breakfast in church from 9.45am and then hold a family friendly service at 10.30am with stories, songs and fun activities.
